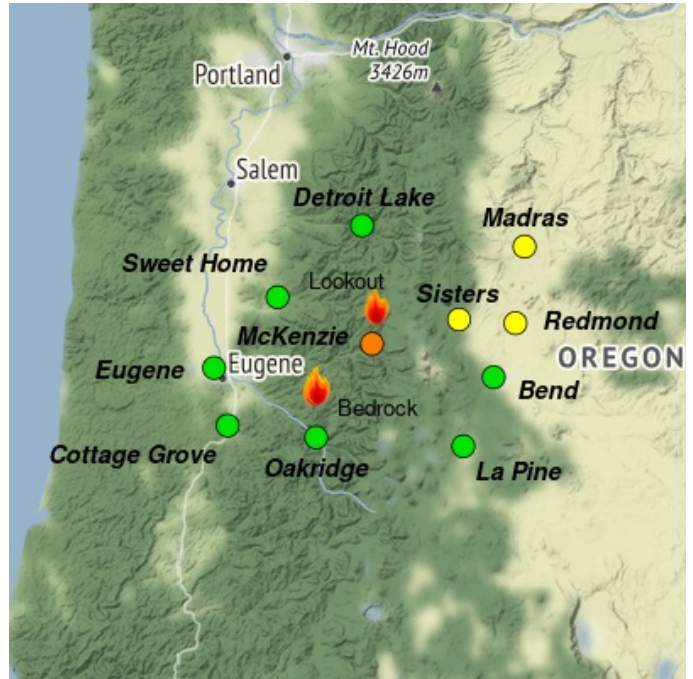

Fire

Smoke

There are plans for some burning operations on the Lookout fire today. If the conditions allow for those operations, we should expect to see more smoke in the area than we have been seeing. McKenzie is starting the day with MODERATE and will likely increase to see periods USG as smoke production increases. The increased smoke production and westerly winds will lead to smoke being pushed from the fire toward Sister and Redmond and may settle down in Bend in the evening and overnight hours. Air quality is likely to be moderate for those locations. The air quality in Detroit Lake, Sweet Home, Eugene, and Cottage Grove should remain GOOD. Like yesterday we will likely continue to see GOOD air quality along the Willamette Valley.

Good	None
