



# Smoke Outlook

## North Central OR/WA Camp Creek

9/12 - 9/13

Issued by Wildland Fire Air Quality Response Program on September 12, 2023 at 07:27 AM PDT

### Fire

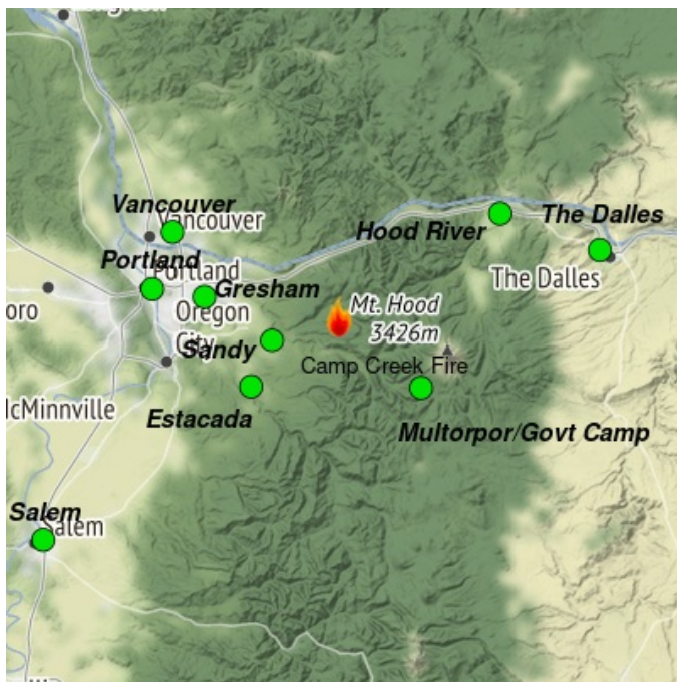
The Camp Creek fire is reported at 2,023 acres with 44% containment. Crews are continuing to make steady progress containing the fire. Fire behavior will be relatively low today and tomorrow with more humid air.

### Smoke

With exception of areas near the Sandy River, smoke impacts are expected to be minimal today and tomorrow. Smoke will continue settling along the Sandy River at night and moving down-slope towards Troutdale, though at lower concentrations than past days. Winds will shift from the west to the northeast late Thursday through early Saturday, so areas to the south and west of the fire could have more smoke impacts compared to recent days.

### Transportation

Patchy fog is in the forecast for tomorrow morning for areas near the Sandy River. Be especially alert while driving in fog-prone areas near the fire, as fog and smoke can combine to create very low visibility.
