
## Fire

The Camp Creek fire is still reported at 1,902 acres with 11% containment. Similar weather conditions compared to yesterday are expected to today, with cool conditions and mild fire behavior. This is the last cold day expected as the weather will become warmer and drier throughout the week, leading to fire behavior becoming more active.

## **Smoke**

With another day of mild fire behavior, the only smoke produced will come from persistent burning within the fire perimeter in thick duff and surface vegetation. With little smoke production expected again today, smoke is not expected to impact any communities in the forecast area. GOOD air quality is expected throughout the area today. On Tuesday, little wind in the morning may bring smoke down the Sandy River into Gresham and Sandy.
