
Issued by Wildland Fire Air Quality Response Program on September 08, 2023 at 07:20 AM PDT

Fire

The Tyee Ridge Complex and other fires in the Outlook area remain active as crews continue to construct line, attack hotspots, and prepare for tactical firing operations. Successful tactical firing operations were accomplished along the NE flank of the Cougar fire yesterday and smaller acreage operations are expected today. Additional details on the fires are available at Tyee Ridge and other fires Inciweb.

Smoke

Heavier concentrations of smoke settled in the Garden Valley and Roseburg areas last night. That smoke will begin to rise and air quality will improve there by late morning. Smoke transport from the Tyee Ridge Complex will generally be to the S/SE today and visible smoke/haze between Sutherlin and Canyonville in the Coles, Garden, Flournoy, and Looking Glass valleys is likely. Generally MODERATE to USG conditions are expected in those communities with potential for periods of Unhealthy overnight. Expect periods of UNHEALTHY conditions in Roseburg this AM, improving through late afternoon, before light smoke returns in the evening/overnight. Smoke concentrations will be lighter in the Cascades with generally GOOD conditions. Monitor air quality by visiting the Fire and Smoke Map.

USG	People within Sensitive Groups* should reduce prolonged or heavy outdoor exertion.
