### Fire


Today will be cooler and more humid than yesterday, but elevated fire weather and smoke production will continue today. Currently the Lookout fire is 24,843 acres with 50% containment. ### Smoke

There will be general haziness area-wide from high level smoke. Winds from the west that began late yesterday changed air quality patterns, with smoke clearing in the Willamette Valley. Areas closest to the fire can expect VERY UNHEALTHY conditions peaking in the afternoon. Areas east of the Cascades are seeing widespread smoke impacts, with Bend and Redmond seeing USG and periods of UNHEALTHY throughout the day. In Madras and La Pine smoke will clear during the day. Air quality will improve with the cooler weather tomorrow and most of the smoke impacts to continue near the fire and east of the Cascades.

Air Quality Index (AQI)	Actions to Protect Yourself
Good	None
Moderate	Unusually sensitive individuals should consider limiting prolonged or heavy exertion.
USG	People within Sensitive Groups* should <b>reduce</b> prolonged or heavy outdoor exertion.
Unhealthy	People within Sensitive Groups* should <b>avoid all</b> physical outdoor activity.
Very Unhealthy	Everyone should avoid prolonged or heavy exertion.
Hazardous	Everyone should avoid any outdoor activity.
