

Fire


The Smith River Complex, Happy Camp Complex, and Six Rivers Forest Lightning Complex are showing some signs of increased activity as the warming and drying trend continues. Strategic firing operations are under consideration at all three fire complexes; some test firing may occur today in the SRF Complex, but heavy smoke impacts are not expected. Smoke

Most of the outlook area should have GOOD to MODERATE air quality today. Gasquet will see more smoke and UNHEALTHY for SENSITIVE GROUPS air quality. As fire activity picks up and smoldering continues, we will see more smoke in the afternoons particularly in Orleans, Forks of Salmon and Weitchpec. And smoke could drain down valley towards Hoopa and Willow Creek, but should remain light. If you are enjoying at day at the beach or in the coastal Redwoods you should have GOOD air quality today, with some hazy skies.
