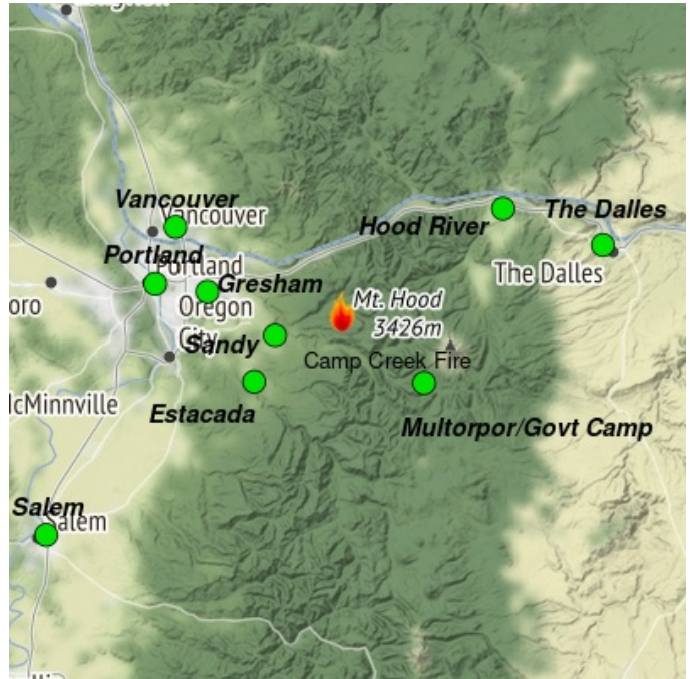

Fire

The Camp Creek fire is reported at 2,055 acres with 51% containment. Fire activity today will be similar to yesterday. Significant fire growth is not expected.

Smoke

The Camp Creek fire is reported at 2,055 acres with 51% containment. Fire activity today will be similar to yesterday. Significant fire growth is not expected. West winds return today for the next few days, which will send periods of light to moderate smoke towards areas from Hood River to Government Camp. Smoke may settle at night in Hood River and the Dalles areas. The pattern of smoke moving down-slope at night and settling in low areas will continue, impacting Troutdale, Gresham, Boring, Sandy, and nearby areas. This smoke will clear out late morning as it moves up the highway 26 corridor towards Sandy and Zigzag late morning through afternoon. Some of this smoke may also move up the Columbia River towards Hood River. Tomorrow, smoke conditions are expected to be similar to today.
