Special Statement

HWY 199 has control access with one-way pilot cars due to falling debris, rocks, and hazard trees. Expect up to 3hr delays and periods of restricted travel. Avoid this area if possible.

Fire


Continued smoldering and interior burning between Gasquet and the state line will produce very visible smoke columns drifting to the SW most of the day. Crews on Smith River Complex will continue to mop-up and secure the northern containment lines. Increasing fire activity from Anvil will produce a very visible smoke column along HWY 101, with high potential to reduce visibility tonight.

Smoke

Overnight smoke impacts will remain until late afternoon. Communities near Agness, Gold Beach, and O'Brien will continue to experience USG-V.UNHEALTHY surface impacts in the morning and evening. Potential for reduced visibility along HWY 199 overnight.
