Special Statement

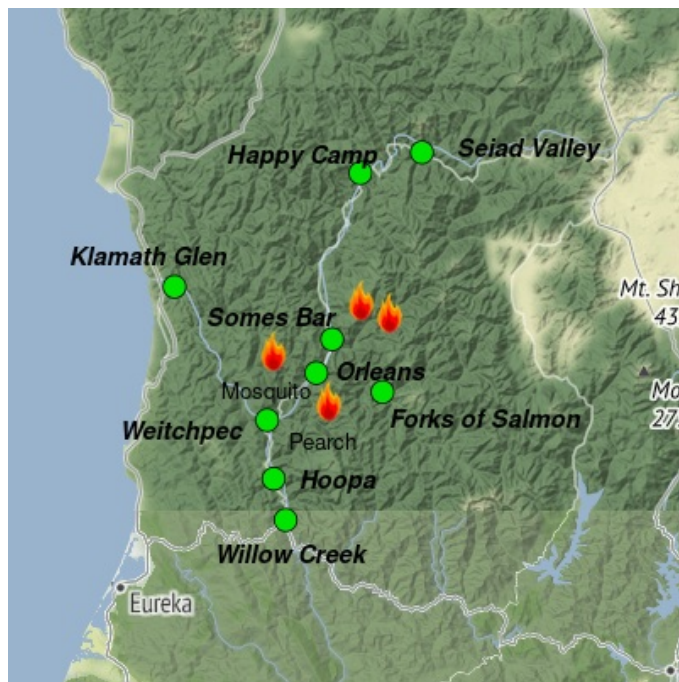
This outlook focuses on Six Rivers Forest (SRF) Lightning Complex, Mosquito & Peach Fires.

Fire

The SRF Lightening Complex Fire Mosquito and Peach fire saw very little growth in the past 24 hours with continuing rains. Smoke in the area will remain within the fire's perimeter with light smoldering and creeping along the fires edge.

Smoke

Overall GOOD air quality throughout today as rains continue and SW winds increase in the area. Willow Creek, Hoopa, weitchpec, and Orleans will continue with GOOD air quality today. Klamath Glen area will see GOOD air quality throughout the day. The Somes Bar area north to Happy Camp and Seiad Valley will see GOOD air quality as SW winds and forecasted rains continue.
