

## **Fire**


The Basin Fire is at 11,909 acres and is continuing to have active fire behavior with uphill runs, running and short-range spotting. Less acreage was consumed yesterday and this will have a positive impact on less smoke being generated.

## Smoke

Smoke from the Basin fire is mostly concentrated in the Kings Canyon river drainage with spill over into the tributaries. Diurnal nighttime downslope winds have pushed the smoke into the Pine Flat Lake, Pinehurst, and Prather areas this morning but as heating occurs today the winds will become upslope and drive the smoke upslope towards the Sierra Crest. Favorable air quality is expected in the Fresno area to the west and in the Bishop and Mammoth Lakes towards the east northeast.
