## Northern California-Coastal Mountains Hill Fire

### Fire

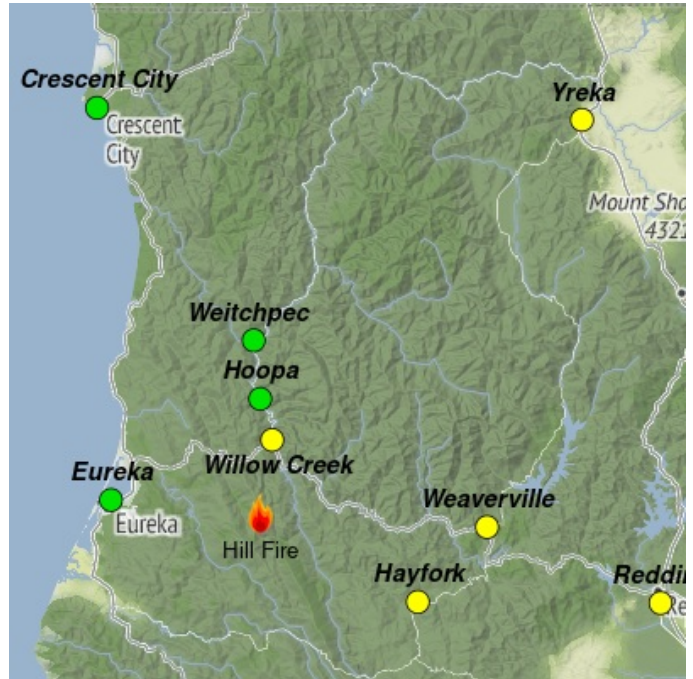
The Hill Fire did not show new growth yesterday and is now 14% contained. The fire continues to actively burn through interior pockets. Cooler weather today and lower winds should tamp down fire activity from what we've seen in the past few days. For the latest fire information on the Hill Fire go to [Inciweb](#).

### Smoke

Winds from the west scoured out smoke from coastal communities and areas north of the Hill Fire. These areas can expect to see GOOD air quality most of today. Areas to the east can expect to see more smoke this afternoon and evening, with MODERATE air quality. The Park Fire outside of Chico may impact Redding today, with the possibility of periods of heavy smoke during the day and night.

Air Quality Index (AQI)	Actions to Protect Yourself
● Good	None
● Moderate	Unusually sensitive individuals should consider limiting prolonged or heavy exertion.
● USG	People within Sensitive Groups* should <b>reduce</b> prolonged or heavy outdoor exertion.
● Unhealthy	People within Sensitive Groups* should <b>avoid all</b> physical outdoor activity.
● Very Unhealthy	Everyone should avoid prolonged or heavy exertion.
● Hazardous	Everyone should avoid any outdoor activity.
