Forecast for Thursday 7/11 -- expected air quality is UNHEALTHY for SENSITIVE GROUPS.

Details Smoke continuing. Best time of day likely is early afternoon. Morning Afternoon Evening Night

Overall USG AQ with AQ ranging from UNHEALTHY to MODERATE AQ.

Forecast for Friday 7/12 -- expected air quality is UNHEALTHY for SENSITIVE GROUPS.

Details Smoke decreasing. Best time of day likely is early afternoon. Morning Afternoon Evening Night

Overall UNHEALTHY AQ with AQ ranging from HAZARDOUS to MODERATE.

Forecast for Extended period -- expected air quality is MODERATE.

Details Smoke decreasing.

Transport winds will carry the smoke towards the north during the day for GOOD AQ, but USG or UNHEALTHY AQ expected at night.
