

## Fire


Fire acitivity was moderate yesterday, but today we are expecting more activity with higher temperatures and lower humidities, and this is likely to continue as the week progresses. The Pyramid Fire is now at 11% containment (1156 acres) and the Slate is holding at 91 acres with 27% containment. The Ore Fire is at 1486 acres and holdig at 29% containment. The 7 fires on the Oakridge lightning complex total 7592 acres. The 217 Fire is now contained (38 acres) and the Chalk fire remains the only other fire with containment at 7%. ## Smoke

Yesterday, we saw much improved air quality in the area, with only communities near the fire briefly seeing Unhealthy. For today, with the possibility of more fire activity, smoke impacts may return across the area. With clear conditions this morning, smoke should hopefully stay aloft, so we are anticipating less severe smoke impacts that we've seen in the last week. As the week progresses, we may start to see more regional smoke impacts from outside our monitoring area start to cause more hazy conditions.

Air Quality Index (AQI)	Actions to Protect Yourself
Good	None
Moderate	Unusually sensitive individuals should consider limiting prolonged or heavy exertion.
USG	People within Sensitive Groups* should <b>reduce</b> prolonged or heavy outdoor exertion.
Unhealthy	People within Sensitive Groups* should <b>avoid all</b> physical outdoor activity.
Very Unhealthy	Everyone should avoid prolonged or heavy exertion.
Hazardous	Everyone should avoid any outdoor activity.
