### Fire



#### Smoke


Widespread haze and significant smoke impacts are expected again today as smoke from multiple large fires as well as many new starts from recent lightning continue to affect the area. In areas with heavy smoke this morning, the smoke will be slow to lift because of a deep inversion. Breezy conditions today are expected to drive active fire behavior and growth. Winds from the west and northwest are expected, pushing smoke into those communities east and southeast of active fires. Those communities will see smoke this afternoon and evening. Pendleton, La Grande, Baker City and Enterprise will see the best air quality with MODERATE conditions expected. Smoke will blow into Ontario this morning with periods of USG to UNHEALTHY conditions throughout the day. Drewsey started the day with VERY UNHEALTHY conditions won't see significant improvements as smoke from Falls, Telephone and other fires will blow smoke into town resulting in UNHEALTHY to VERY UNHEALTHY conditions to persist.
