 Numerous fires and fire complexes are ongoing within the Cascades. For the latest fire information, see <https://inciweb.wildfire.gov/>

Smoke
 Today's smoke is expected to continue having the largest impact to communities east of the Cascades with conditions reaching USG to UNHEALTHY along the Highway 97 corridor. West of the Cascades, GOOD conditions are likely today with little to no impact along the I-5 corridor. Smoke may settle further west and southwest leading to increased smoke impacts in these areas tomorrow. Overall, expecting continued smoke or an increase in smoke across the forecast area on Thursday. Smoke from fires burning in California are also expected to impact communities in southwest Oregon this week.

Crescent					Periods of MODERATE to UNHEALTHY throughout the forecast period.		
Crater Lake					GOOD to MODERATE conditions, possibly reaching USG at times.		
Summer Lake	No hourly data				UNHEALTHY conditions this morning; GOOD to MODERATE this afternoon/evening		
Grants Pass					Brief MODERATE conditions possible, but otherwise GOOD conditions today		
Medford					Brief MODERATE conditions possible, but otherwise GOOD conditions today		
Klamath Falls					Smoke this morning with up to UNHEALTHY AQI; Clear this afternoon		
Canyonville	No hourly data				GOOD to MODERATE AQI expected with possible haze.		
Glide					Mostly GOOD air quality with possible impacts as smoke pushes west this week.		
Diamond Lake					MODERATE to USG Conditions, with periods of UNHEALTHY as smoke settles.
