# Swawilla Fire

Here's what you need to know.

## Evacuation levels



**Level 1** - Danger is nearby, prepare by staying informed, have a plan on where to go and how to get there, begin moving people with disabilities and any livestock



**Level 2** - High danger in your area, follow your evacuation plan, relocate people and animals to safety



**Level 3** - Danger is expected, leave now, stay at your own risk; if fire reaches you do NOT leave so that roads are clear for EMS

**Updates:** Shelter in Coulee Dam will be relocated to Ferry County Fairgrounds in Republic on Sunday after lunch. Pets, large animals and livestock can be accommodated in addition to people. They have received donations of feed for a variety of animals.

As of this afternoon we are no longer able to assist in evacuation efforts in Level 3 areas due to safety concerns for our staff.

Rebecca Lake Road is now open. Buffalo Lake Road is now open. There is still a checkpoint at Peter Dan Cutoff/Buffalo Lake Road junction.

**Current conditions:** Dry conditions with seasonable temperatures through this weekend. Over 500 people from across the country and several hot shot crews are now fighting the fires.

**Forecast:** Moderate humidity expected Mon/Tues, low risk of thunderstorms. High pressure system is coming and will likely bring increasing temperatures next week.

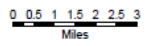
