Evecuation levels

Level 1 - Danger is nearby, prepare by staying informed, have a plan on where to go and how to get there, begin moving people with disabilities and any livestock



Level 2 - High danger in your area, follow your evacuation plan, relocate people and animals to safety



Level 3 - Danger is expected, stay at your own risk, if fire reaches you do NOT leave to keep roads clear for EMS etc.

Updates: Fuel pumps at Keller Store are working. Bridge Creek Road is open. 500 people on the crew fighting both Bridge and Swawilla fires including 2 hot shot crews. Tankers and helicopters are assisting.

Current conditions: Swawilla increased by 10,000 acres in the past day to over 40,000 acres, still 10% contained. Next few days will provide a window to reduce the fire.

Forecast: Next few days will have westerly winds (6-12 mph). High pressure system will impact area Thursday/Friday (Aug. 1-2) and could dry out what greenery is left on the ground.
