Dollar/Oro Fire Area, Trail, and Road Closure

PROHIBITIONS

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. § 551 and 36 C.F.R. § 261.50 (a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited on the National Forest System (NFS) lands, roads, and trails within the Cascade Ranger District, Boise National Forest, described below and shown on the attached map incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A (the “Described Area, Roads, and Trails”).

1. Going into or being upon the Described Area. 36 CFR § 261.52(e).
2. Being on the Described Roads. 36 CFR § 261.54(e).
3. Being on the Described Trails. 36 CFR § 261.55(a).

EXEMPTIONS

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with Forest Service Permit No. FS-7700-48 (Permit for Use of Roads, Trails, or Areas Restricted by Regulation or Order), specifically exempting them from this Order or a written determination by a Forest Service authorized officer that a permit is not required under 36 C.F.R. § 251.50(e)(1) or (2).
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Federal or State administrative personnel in the performance of an official duty.

DESCRIBED AREA, ROADS, AND TRAILS

The Described Area is all NFS lands within the following boundaries: Beginning from the intersection of the Boise National Forest boundary and NFS Road #474 in Section 1, Township 16 North, Range 6 East; continuing South on NFS Road #474 to its junction with NFS Road #22 (Warm Lake Highway) in Section 1, Township 15 North, Range 6 east; Continuing Southwest on and excluding NFS Road #22 to the intersection of NFS Road #22 and the West boundary of Section 11, Township 15N, Range 6 East; Continuing South on the section line to the SE corner of Section 22, Township 14 North 6 East; Continuing West to its intersection with NFS Road #409 in the Southern boundary of Section 19, Township 14 North, Range 6 East; Continuing Southwest and including NFS Road #409 to the Boise NF Forest boundary; Continuing North along the Boise NF Forest boundary to where the Boise NF Forest boundary meets the Southwest corner of Section

30, Township 15 North, Range 5 East; continuing north to the Southeast corner of Section 13, Township 15 North, Range 5 East; Continuing West along the section line to the Boise NF Forest boundary at the Southwest corner of Section 13, Township 15 North, Ranger 4 East; continuing North and Northeast along the Boise NF Forest boundary to the intersection of the Boise NF Forest boundary and NFS Road #474 the beginning point.

The Described Area is located within the Boise National Forest, Cascade Ranger District, Boise Meridian, Valley County, Idaho.

The Described Roads are all NFS Roads located within and bordering the Described Area: NFS Roads #400, #400A, #400A1, #400C, #400C1, #400C3, #400C6, #400I, #400J, #400N, #400O, #400P, #400T, #402, #402B, #402C, #402D, #402E, #402F, #402F1, #402G, #402G1, #402I, #402I1, #402I2, #406, #406A, #407, #407A, #407B, #407D, #407D1, #407D2, #407X, #409, #409C, #409D, #409E, #409E1, #409G, #411, #418, #418A, #418A1, #418A2, #418A3, #419, #433, #433.2, #433A, #433B, #474, #474A, #474,B, #474C, #474D, #474D1, #474M, #474, #475, #483, #493, #495, #497A, #497A1, #497G, #497G1, #497H, #497J, #497L, #497L1, #498, #498B, #498B1, #498B2, #498D, #498E, #498E1, #498E2, #498E3, #498E4, #498F, #498F1.

The Described Trails are all NFS Trails located within and bordering the Described Area: NFS Trails #001, #014, #080, #101, #106, #107, #111, #114, #115, #150, #162, #224, #225.

PURPOSE

The purpose of this Order is to protect public safety during the Dollar/Oro Fires.

IMPLEMENTATION

1. This Order shall be in effect from **August 8, 2024, at 07:00 AM through December 31, 2024, at 11:59 PM**, unless rescinded.
2. A map identifying the Described Area, Roads, and Trails is attached and made part of this Order as Exhibit A. For a digital version of this Order and Exhibit A, go to <https://www.fs.usda.gov/alerts/Boise/alerts-notices>.
3. Unless otherwise expressly defined in this Order, the terms used in this Order are defined by the regulations of the Secretary of Agriculture, 36 C.F.R. Chapter II, Parts 200-299. If there are terms in this Order that are not expressly defined in the Order or 36 C.F.R. Chapter II, Parts 200-299, their meaning shall be determined by their plain language definitions.
4. A violation of the above prohibitions is punishable as a Class B misdemeanor by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for individuals and \$10,000 for organizations, or by imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. 16 U.S.C. § 551; 18 U.S.C. §§ 3559, 3571, and 3581.
