

Fire


Expect active fire behavior over the next few days due to increased winds from the predicted storms. The Limepoint Fire grew by about 1,400 acres yesterday, bringing the total to 31,256 acres burned, with containment remaining unchanged. Smoke

Northern winds this morning, followed by West-Southwest winds later in the day, will push smoke mostly to the east. The Limepoint Fire, Boulder Fire, Middle Fork Fire Complex, and Snag Fire are the primary sources of smoke today, leading to MODERATE to UNHEALTHY air quality in this Outlook. Areas west of Interstate 84 and the Highway 55 corridor should see improved air quality.
