
Fire

Town Gulch and Paddock fires did not increase significantly yesterday. There are a number of very active incidents (Snag, Boulder, and the Middle Fork Complex) that are negatively influencing air quality for Cascade, Idaho City, and Grand Valley. Smoke

Smoke from all area fires will be terrain-driven with a general southerly movement. Around noon smoke will begin to shift from the N to W-SW with SW becoming prominent midafternoon onward before smoke retreats to muddle in the late evening then move again S in the late night hours. This trend will show general clearing in communities along the ID-95 corridor. However, Cascade, Garden Valley, and Idaho City will continue to see impaired AQI conditions. Expect GOOD to MODERATE conditions to continue for Enterprise, Riggins, and Grangeville. Halfway, OR should see improvement today. However, SW winds will move any smoke from Town Gulch over this community this afternoon.
