Fire

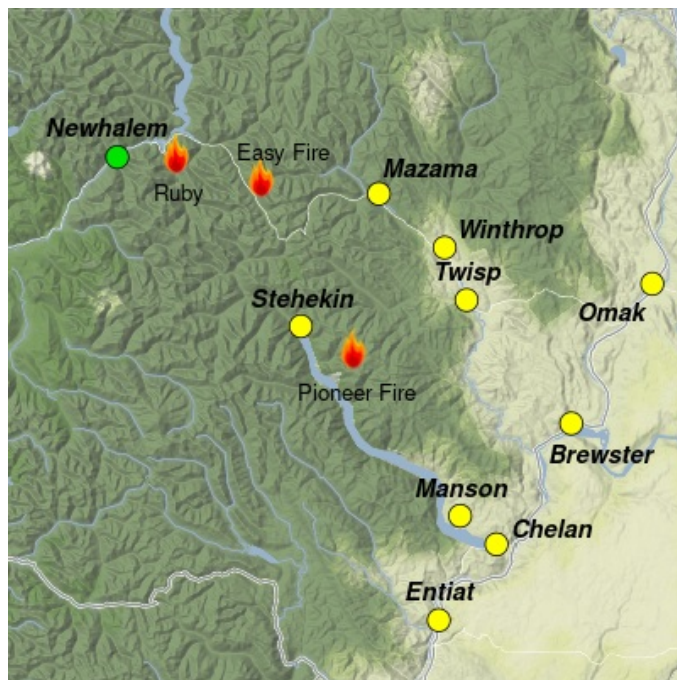
The Easy Fire is 2,130 acres with no growth and is 0% contained. The Pioneer Fire is 38,480 acres with 60 acres of growth and is 13% contained. Expect minimal fire behavior with backing, creeping and smoldering. For latest information, visit [Inciweb Pioneer Fire](#) and [Inciweb Easy Fire](#).

Smoke

The Stehekin Valley recorded several hours of GOOD AQ once again overnight due to persistent moderate NW winds keeping the smoke from the northern edge of the Pioneer fire to the south. Smoke will increase some in this valley when winds shift to updrainage later this morning through this afternoon. Elsewhere, the region will continued to see improved conditions today with more hours of GOOD AQ as a result of very minimal fire activity and smoke production. Some smoke increase may occur late tonight or Thursday as transport winds become southerly and potentially tap smoke from fires to our south.
