



Smoke

This will be the final Smoke Outlook for North Central Washington for the Pioneer and Easy fires. GOOD AQ will prevail across all communities on the eastside of the Cascades today and foreseeable future, barring no new starts. The upper Skagit river valley will see times of MODERATE AQ at night, otherwise GOOD AQ will prevail.
