Fire


We are expecting more activity again today with even higher temperatures across the region. The Coffeepot Fire (3956 acres) could significantly increase smoke production today with active fire along its perimeter. The Chalk Fire (3655 acres) remains the only active fire on the Oakridge Complex with containment (40%). To the north, the Pyramid Fire is now 1193 acres (13% contained) and crews are holding the Slate Fire at 91 acres and gained 77% containment. The Ore Fire is at 1539 acres and holding at 29% containment.

Smoke

Yesterday's active fires led to heavy smoke impacts in areas close to the fires. Today, smoke impacts are expected to return in and around Oakridge - Very Unhealthy to Hazardous possible depending on the level of fire activity. McKenzie should also see smoke impacts reaching Unhealthy. Further east of the fires, smoke should stay aloft and keep clear of areas like Sisters and Bend, whereas smoke is expected to impact La Pine and even further south beyond our monitoring area.

Monitoring Update

The McKenzie monitor was moved yesterday to the McKenzie Ranger Station. Concentrations are expected to be lower due to its new location being further from the fire. A Purple Air sensor is still at the high school for more localized air quality information.
