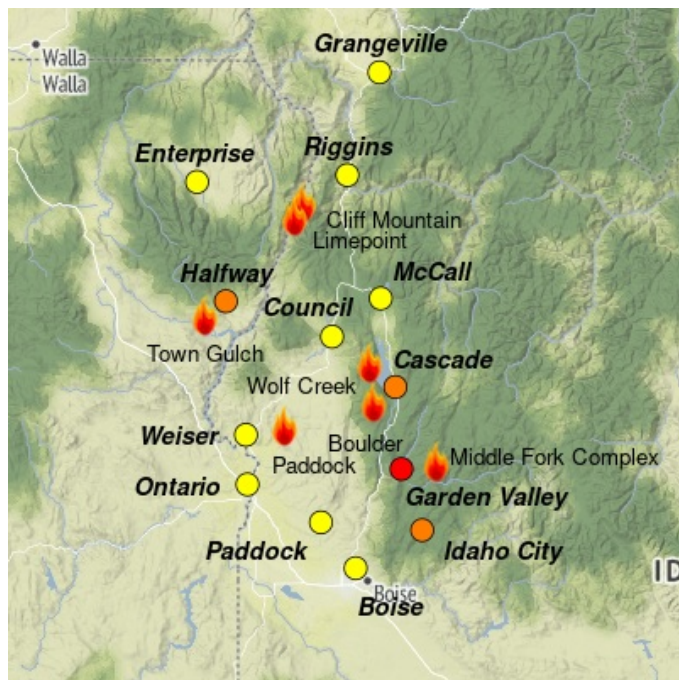

The Limepoint Fire now stands at 29,832 acres burned with 27% containment. Smoke

SW trends move smoke to the NE throughout the day today. Smoke from Town Gulch, OR; Limepoint, ID; Boulder-Bulldog-Nellie Anderson (Middle Fork Complex), ID; Snag, ID, are the primary smoke producers today moving poor AQI into this Outlook. Overall, with the exception of Garden Valley which retained UNH, most communities maintained or improved AQI yesterday and the same is expected today as the SW pattern continues. Early morning rain may also mitigate smoke impacts by bringing needed moisture over these incidents.
