8/14 - 8/15

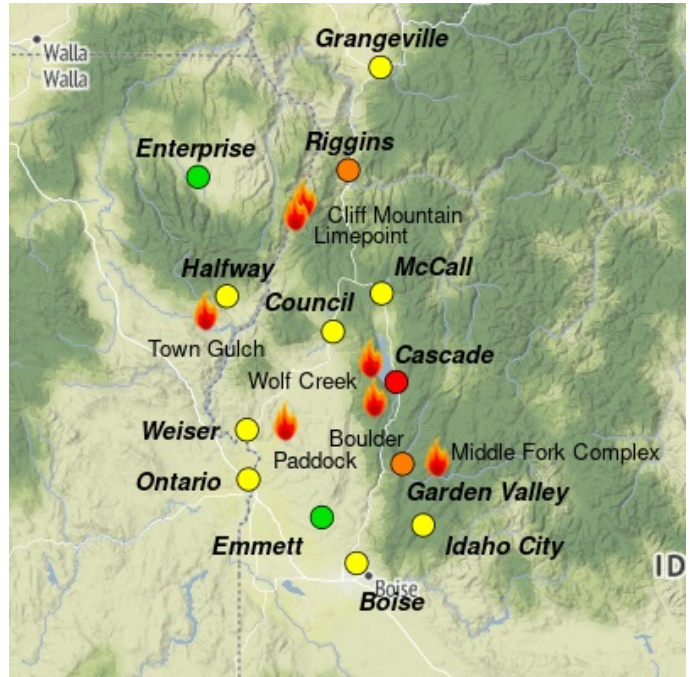

Fire

Expect moderate fire activity today, with slightly less intensity compared to previous days. The Limepoint Fire showed minimal growth, but other fires near Cascade, particularly the Snag Fire, saw noticeable expansion. Containment remains largely unchanged. Smoke

Moderate smoke production overnight and today, along with smoke mixing down to ground level, will reduce air quality in areas near the fires, particularly overnight. The Limepoint Fire, Boulder Fire, Middle Fork Fire Complex, and Snag Fire are the main sources of smoke today, resulting in MODERATE to UNHEALTHY air quality in this Outlook. Areas west of Interstate 84 and the Highway 55 corridor should experience improved air quality.

Air Quality Index (AQI)	Actions to Protect Yourself
Good	None
Moderate	Unusually sensitive individuals should consider limiting prolonged or heavy exertion.
USG	People within Sensitive Groups* should reduce prolonged or heavy outdoor exertion.
Unhealthy	People within Sensitive Groups* should avoid all physical outdoor activity.
Very Unhealthy	Everyone should avoid prolonged or heavy exertion.
Hazardous	Everyone should avoid any outdoor activity.
