
Red Flag Warning for Eastern Central Idaho

Fire

Expect moderated fire activity today as higher humidity and showers are forecasted over the area. The Limepoint Fire showed minimal growth, but other fires near Cascade, particularly the Snag Fire, saw noticeable expansion. Containment is in creasing on the Limepoint, but remains largely unchanged on fires in the West Mountain Complex Fires near Lake Cascade. Smoke

Heavy smoke production overnight is expected to continue today, but gusty winds should help push much of it to the northeast of the Highway 55 corridor. The Limepoint Fire, Boulder Fire, Middle Fork Fire Complex, and Snag Fire are the primary sources of smoke, leading to MODERATE air quality in this Outlook. Areas west of the U.S. Route 95 corridor should see improved air quality.
