**Update:** Crews had another busy day yesterday moving hose lays off the mountain, all while increasing containment to 93%! Brief showers moved through the area, further diminishing smoke and hot spots along the fire perimeter. Larger areas were moved to patrol status, and base camp began the process of packing up and moving to the Brinnon Fire Department.

The last few steps of the transition to the Type 4 Incident Commander, Dan Lacy, and the WA DNR is almost complete. The incoming ICT 4 and the outgoing Management Teams are grateful for the outpouring of support and generosity from the community during this time. We know the fire has impacted everyone, and it won't be long before the mountain, and its community are back to its peaceful state.

Air Restrictions: The Temporary Flight Restriction (TFR) has been lifted

**Weather:** The weather pattern will be warming into the 80's this week, and the chance of rain continues to lesson, but the seasonal chance of afternoon showers will continue.
