Fire

Firing operations were completed earlier this week on the Retreat Fire W of Yakima with an increase in containment expected soon. The Retreat Fire is 45,601 acres and 70% contained. Meanwhile, the Williams Mine Fire continues to burn actively on the S side of Mt Adams, but higher humidity and cooler temperatures have slowed. It is 10,968 acres and 0% contained. The Miners Complex NNW of Wenatchee received significant wetting rainfall Monday. It is 1,098 acres and 0% contained. The Lodgepole Fire near Hwy 410 16 miles W of Cliffdell, WA is approx 37 acres and 0% containment. Visit Inciweb for more information on these and other fires in the Pacific NW.

Smoke

Mostly GOOD air quality is expected today due to cooler temperature and higher humidity w/some periods of MODERATE across southern areas due to the fires. Smoke from the Williams Mine Fire is expected to be the primary smoke producer through the forecast period w/some lesser contributions from the other area fires. MODERATE w/periods of UNHEALTHY for SENSITIVE GROUPS (USG) are likely at times mainly N of Goldendale, across much of the Yakima Nation SW of Yakima. GOOD to MODERATE air quality is generally expected to continue Thu, but decreasing winds are likely to result in a gradual increase in areal smoke through late this week.
