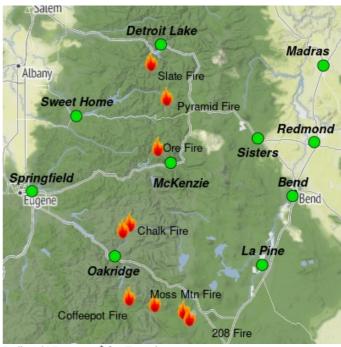
Issued by Wildland Fire Air Quality Response Program on August 20, 2024 at 07:17 AM PDT

Fire

Fires continue to grow minimally as a result of prior days precipitation and higher humidities over the area. Some possible increase in fire activity is expected as a result of drying of fuels and clear skies. Good progress continues to be made that limits fire spread. Current acreages sit at: Chalk (5,676) acres; Moss Mountain (844 acres); Coffeepot (6,176 acres) Ore (3,142 acres); Pyramid (1,312 acres).

Smoke

All areas may experience GOOD air quality for the day. River valleys and drainages near all fires will continue to have smoke lingering in the morning but will be minimal for the next two days. Some increased smoke may occur today and tomorrow as a result of drying trends and smoke expected to disperse to the east of the Cascades. Expect air quality to remain mostly GOOD in the next few days with further improvement as a result of possible precipitation in the forecast.
