## Fire

Firing operations were completed earlier this week on the Retreat Fire W of Yakima with an increase in containment expected soon. The Retreat Fire is 45,601 acres and 70% contained. Meanwhile, the Williams Mine Fire continues to burn actively on the S side of Mt Adams. It is 11,149 acres and 2% contained. The Lodgepole Fire near Hwy 410 16 miles W of Cliffdell, WA is approx 35 acres and 0% containment. Visit Inciweb for more information on these and other fires in the Pacific NW.

## Smoke

Generally GOOD air quality is expected today and Friday across northern areas with increasing areal coverage and duration of MODERATE air quality across central and southern portions of the area. Smoke from the Williams Mine Fire is expected to be the primary smoke producer through the forecast period w/some lesser contributions from the other area fires. MODERATE w/periods of UNHEALTHY for SENSITIVE GROUPS (USG) are likely at times mainly N of Goldendale, across much of the Yakima Nation SW of Yakima, and in the Prosser area. Low pressure approaching from the south Saturday will shift winds with broader regional smoke likely to bring MODERATE air quality to some areas, but GOOD in others.
