# S Central Washington - Retreat & Lodgepole Fires

#### Fire

Fire activity began to increase on the Williams Mine Fire late yesterday due to warmer and drier weather. Activity on the Williams Mine Fire is expected to increase further today due to dry and breezy conditions ahead of low pressure that will bring significant, wetting rainfall from showers and thunderstorms this evening. Fire activity will then rapidly diminish this evening to overnight due to the rainfall. Other area fires may also increase in activity today, but activity is expected to remain minimal. The Retreat Fire 14 miles WSW of Naches is 45,601 acres and 80% contained, the Williams Mine Fire on the SW side of Mt Adams is 11.381 acres and 2% contained, the Lodgepole Fire near Hwy 410 16 miles W of Cliffdell, WA is approx 22 acres and 66% containment. ### Smoke

Air quality will be GOOD today though a brief period of MODERATE air quality is likely this evening east thru southeast of the Williams Mine Fire in the Goldendale area. GOOD air quality is then likely Sunday and Monday due to diminished fire activity as a result of the significant wetting rainfall on the fires in the area. There is a small possibility of new lightning fires outside of the areas of rain that could lead to some smoke concerns in the days ahead.
