Fire



Smoke

Visible satellite imagery shows a broad region of smoke and haze across the region this morning. Air quality levels are MODERATE at all locations. MODERATE levels are expected to continue for most of the day today, although the forecast calls for a period of UNHEALTHY FOR SENSITIVE GROUPS conditions in the afternoon at those locations closest to local fires (Dayville, Spray, Monument). Similar levels of smoke and haze are expected again tomorrow.
