

Fire


Numerous fires are actively burning within the Cascades. Note some fires are being managed within a complex, such as the Homestead and Diamond Complexes. For the latest fire information, see https://inciweb.wildfire.gov/

Smoke

We haven't had the winds we would need to scour out the smoke that has blanketed much of the outlook area. Communities nearest the active burning, along the eastern Cascades, will continue to experience UNHEALTHY air quality and heavy smoke. Smoke could also reduce visibility, particularly along Hwy 138, so care should be taken when traveling between Glide and Diamond Lake. Communities along the I-5 corridor should feel some improvement today with mostly GOOD to MODERATE air quality and some haze.
