Fire

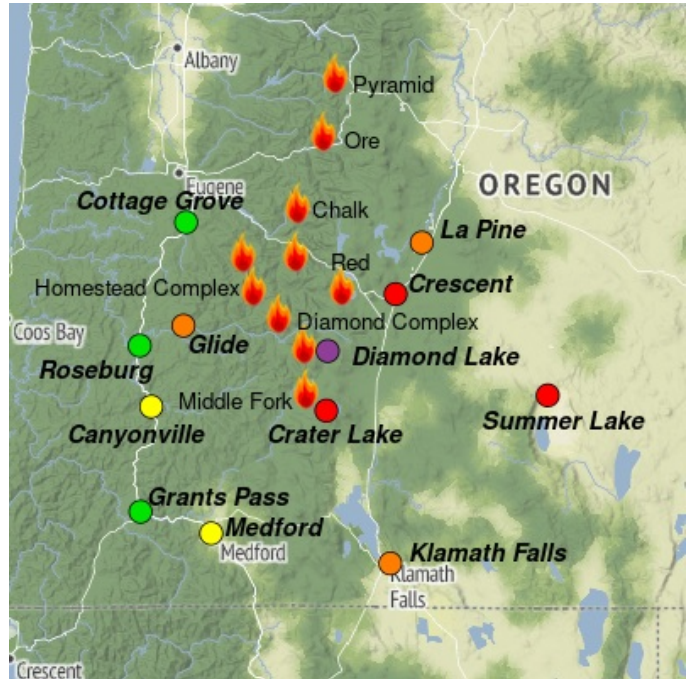
Numerous fires and fire complexes are ongoing within the Cascades. For the latest fire information, see <https://inciweb.wildfire.gov/>

Smoke

Smoke expected along I5 corridor again today, but not as impactful as yesterday with primarily MODERATE conditions at times. Areas within the National Forest(s) near fires will continue to see UNHEALTHY to HAZARDOUS conditions, especially along Highway 138. Largest impacts will continue to be east of fires where (VERY) UNHEALTHY conditions will continue; Enhanced impacts to Crater Lake, especially north rim, likely with significant smoke from Middle Fork Fire. Hazy conditions will be likely throughout the area due to local and regional fires. Chance of thunderstorms this weekend may create rapidly changing conditions - stay aware!

Grants Pass			GOOD to MODERATE air quality, with hazy skies this weekend		
Glide			Smoke expected midday, reaching periods of USG to UNHEALTHY at times		
Diamond Lake			UNHEALTHY to HAZARDOUS conditions as smoke settles from nearby fires		
Crater Lake			Increased smoke from nearby fires, but possible improvements midday		
La Pine			Mostly Moderate today, smoke expected to return this evening.		
Crescent			Brief improvement in the afternoons but UNHEALTHY conditions persist		
Summer Lake	No hourly data		Afternoon improvement to MODERATE; Becoming UNHEALTHY overnight		
Klamath Falls			MODERATE to USG expected as smoke settles into the area		
Medford			GOOD to MODERATE AQI expected with worst conditions in the afternoon

Air Quality Index (AQI)	Actions to Protect Yourself
Good	None
Moderate	Unusually sensitive individuals should consider limiting prolonged or heavy exertion.
USG	People within Sensitive Groups* should reduce prolonged or heavy outdoor exertion.
Unhealthy	People within Sensitive Groups* should avoid all physical outdoor activity.
Very Unhealthy	Everyone should avoid prolonged or heavy exertion.
Hazardous	Everyone should avoid any outdoor activity.
