

## Fire


Fires continue to grow minimally, with interior pockets burning. Crews are making good progress on all containment lines. Fires on adjacent forests will continue to impact the Willamette National Forest and surrounding communities.

## **Smoke**

Smoke will continue to plague communities on the east side of the forecast area, in particular to the southeast. La Pine is expected to have UNHEALTHY air quality, while Bend may see USG (Unhealthy for Sensitive Groups) much of the day. McKenzie, Redmond, Madras, Sisters, and Oakridge should expect MODERATE air quality, with spikes to USG possible in the afternoon. Detroit, Sweet Home and Springfield will be favored with GOOD air quality as winds blow smoke east. River valleys near all fires will continue to have thick smoke hanging out in the mornings.
