
Fire Weather Watch Saturday for LOW RELATIVE HUMIDITY and HIGH WINDS.

Fire

Outlook fires are near containment - Crazy Creek is 79%, Falls is 95%, Telephone is 89% contained Multiple large fire incidents remain very active throughout the west. For more information on these incidents, please visit Inciweb.

Smoke

Reduced fire activity over Outlook area has led to GOOD air quality with the exception of Burns. Weather will confine smokiest conditions to the proximity of smoldering fires. The forecast is for largely GOOD conditions over most of the area through the afternoon. Air quality is expected to be GOOD through Saturday with potential for decreased air quality beginning Sunday.
