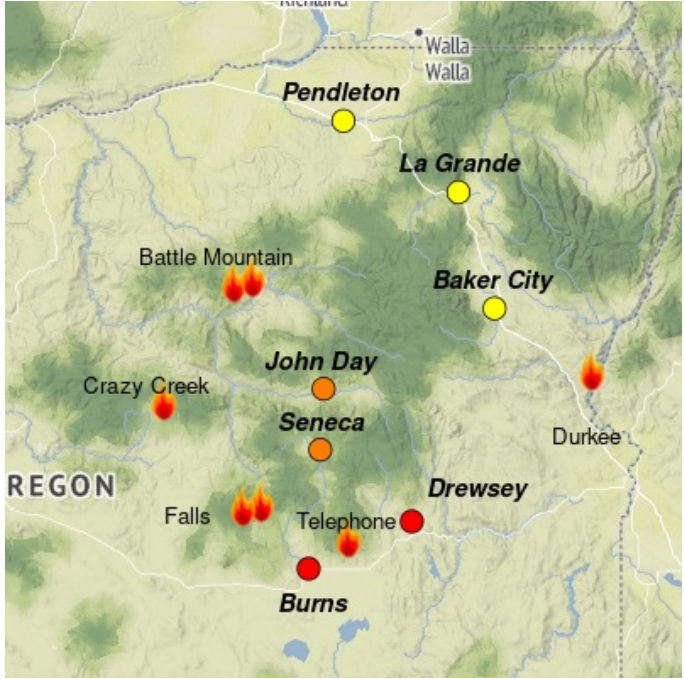

Smoke

Regional smoke from fires within Oregon will reduce Air Quality over a large area this weekend. Locations over southern Oregon from John Day to Burns, and west along highway 20 will see the worst AQ. Limited improvements will begin to occur Sunday. The further one goes north in the region toward Baker City and Pendleton will see improvements in AQ. Good	None
Moderate	Unusually sensitive individuals should consider limiting prolonged or heavy exertion.
USG	People within Sensitive Groups* should reduce prolonged or heavy outdoor exertion.
Unhealthy	People within Sensitive Groups* should avoid all physical outdoor activity.
Very Unhealthy	Everyone should avoid prolonged or heavy exertion.
Hazardous	Everyone should avoid any outdoor activity.
