# Special Statement

Air Quality Advisories issued for Deschutes, Klamath, and Lake counties ending Monday afternoon, Aug. 19 by the Department of Environmental Quality: see the Oregon Smoke Blog for details. Additional Smoke Outlooks and updated air quality information are at the Fire and Smoke Map. If you see smoke and smell smoke, you're breathing smoke.

#### Fire


A Red Flag Warning due to critical fire weather conditions has been issued for the area and over multiple active fires burning within the Cascades. A combination of possible abundant lightning and dry fuels could promote rapid fire spread. The latest fire information is at Inciweb's Wildfire Information.

#### **Smoke**

Smoke levels could initially increase due to thunderstorm downdraft and outflow winds, but levels should decrease as rain washes smoke out of the air. Be aware of changing conditions. Areas nearest the fires and east of the Cascades will see some relief for a few days. Visitors to Diamond and Crater Lakes may experience periods of heavier smoke. The I-5 corridor continues in GOOD and MODERATE for the next few days.

## **Red Flag Warning**

Until 11 pm tonight: National Weather Service has issued a Red Flag Warning for much of OR. Thunderstorm activity on dry fuels could result in new fire starts that could spread rapidly due to possible gusty winds.
