Special Statement

Air Quality Advisories issued for Deschutes, Klamath, and Lake counties will be lifted this afternoon (Aug 19) by the Department of Environmental Quality: see the Oregon Smoke Blog for details. Additional Smoke Outlooks and updated air quality information are at the Fire and Smoke Map. If you see or smell smoke, you're breathing smoke.

Fire

Saturday's rain has quieted fires and reduced smoke overall in the area. Cooler and wetter weather has dampened the multiple active fires burning within the Cascades. Some fires are being managed within a complex, such as Homestead and Diamond Complexes. The latest fire information is at Inciweb's Wildfire Information.

Smoke

Smoke levels have decreased due to the rain, but drying of fuels over then next few days could increase fire activity and smoke production will resume. Areas nearest the fires and east of the Cascades will see some relief for a few days. Visitors to Diamond and Crater Lakes are unlikely to experience much, if any, smoke for a day or two. The I-5 corridor continues in GOOD for the next few days. Slight chance of rain Wednesday increasing toward the end of the week will bring more relief from smoke.
