## **Fire**

The Middle Fork Complex: Bulldog and Nellie Fires, totals 15,629 acres. The Wapiti Fire is 4,943 acres, and the Flat Fire is at 3,278 acres. Yesterday's Red Flag conditions lead to fire growth across the landscape. Today, hot and dry conditions persist. Expect group torching, spotting with wind and terrain influenced runs and a longer burning period. ## **Smoke**

With hot and dry conditions continuing, highly visible smoke plumes will develop early today. Heaviest daytime smoke impacts will be upwind of fires, specially along HWY-21 from Grandjean into Stanley. Overnight drainage smoke will settle in valleys and low-lying areas near the immediate vicinity of active fire. Smoky conditions are highly dependant on today's active fire weather and resultant growth. Until more moderated fire behavior arrives, daily intermittent smoke is anticipated.
