

- Know which hazards are most likely to occur in your area.
- Sign up for local alerts.
- Create and practice an emergency plan.





- Be alert to your environment.
- Stay tuned to notification systems and local media.
- Prepare to take protective actions.
- If you anticipate evacuations, leave early if you have large animals, need extra time, or feel your life is in danger.



- Evacuate immediately as instructed by officials.
- Bring your pets and emergency supply kit.



## STAY!

- Shelter in place.
- Close and lock windows and doors, turn off ventilation systems, move to an interior room, and stay tuned to local notification systems.



## AVOID!

• Stay away from the designated area.



- It is safe for residents and/or businesses to return to an area that has previously been in the GO! Or AVOID! Stage.
- The area may not yet be open to the public.
