

## Fire

Yesterday saw a rise in fire activity and smoke production throughout the Long Valley due to an extended dry period and warmer temperatures ahead of a dry cold front. Today, conditions will be drier, with tactical firing operations planned to secure sections of line on the Snag and Dollar fires. Expected fire behavior includes, creeping, backing, and group tree torching. Additional information can be found at West Mountain Fires Inciweb

## **Smoke**

Increased fire activity produced higher concentrations of smoke throughout the Long Valley during the early morning hours yesterday which resulted in air quality ranging from MODERATE to VERY UNHEALTHY. Strong SW winds brought clean air into the region, although the arrival of clean air was delayed compared to the previous days. Like most mornings, pooling smoke will impact the southern Long Valley. Northwest winds are expected to keep Grangeville and McCall with relatively clean air throughout the day. After pooling smoke clears, Cascade should generally see GOOD air quality, although periods of MODERATE are possible until morning smoke mixes out. Northwest winds should also provide some relief for North Fork and Salmon today, as air quality is expected to range from GOOD to MODERATE. Air quality impacts are expected to be the most severe at Horsethief Reservoir. Expect periods of VERY UNHEALTHY air quality in the morning hours before cleaner air arrives in the early afternoon hours.
