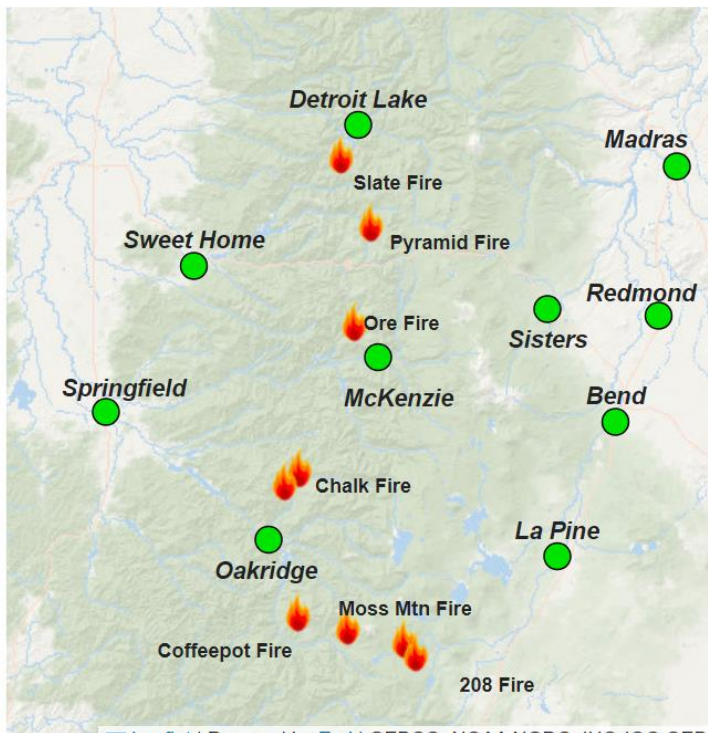


Smoke Forecast Outlook – Willamette Complex Issued August 26, 2024 at 0730 AM PDT

Daily AQI Forecast for August 26

Smoke: Today’s forecast is similar to yesterday with GOOD air quality expected across the entire area. Expect continued overall GOOD air quality throughout the region in the next two days, with high elevation haze visible. Areas immediately adjacent to active fires may see some smoke. Overall, impacts should be minimal and localized. Air quality may decline to MODERATE as the warm/dry spell continues later this week.

Fire: Fire growth has been minimal in the last few days as a result of more favorable weather conditions. With expected warmer and drier conditions later in the week fire activity may slightly increase and lead to a change in fire activity. Some small interior areas or heavy fuels may continue to burn and smolder. Good progress continues to be made that limits fire spread. Current acreages sit at: Chalk (5,684) acres; Moss Mountain (864 acres); Coffeepot (6,179 acres) Ore (3,147 acres); Pyramid (1,312 acres)

| ● Good | None |
| ● Moderate | Unusually sensitive individuals should consider limiting prolonged or heavy exertion. |
| ● USG | People within Sensitive Groups* should reduce prolonged or heavy outdoor exertion. |
| ● Unhealthy | People within Sensitive Groups* should avoid all physical outdoor activity. |
| ● Very Unhealthy | Everyone should avoid prolonged or heavy exertion. |
