### Fire

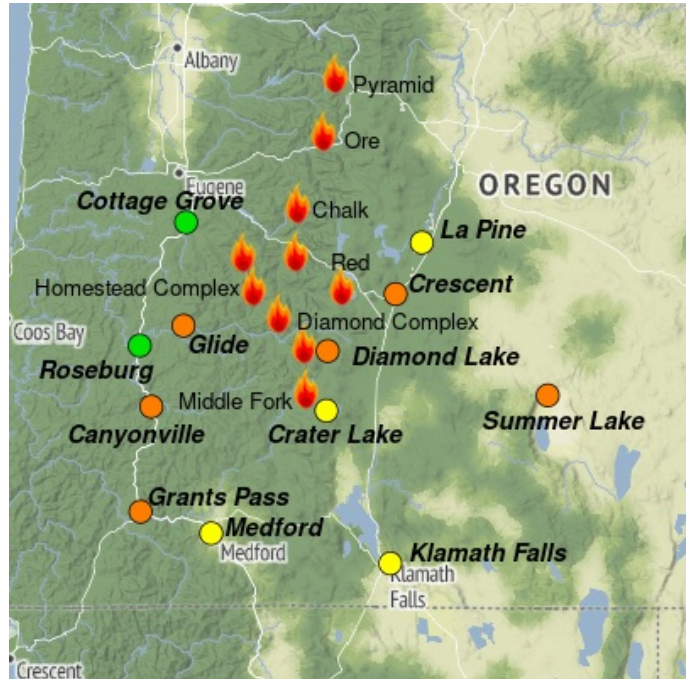
Numerous fires and fire complexes are ongoing within the Cascades. For the latest fire information, see <https://inciweb.wildfire.gov/>

### Smoke

Rain showers brought some relief east of the Cascades yesterday, but smoke likely returns today. Some areas west of Cascades saw smoke settle and lingering this morning with up to UNHEALTHY conditions. Otherwise, periods of haze and at least MODERATE conditions expected along the I-5 corridor. Areas within the National Forest(s) near fires and to the east will continue to see UNHEALTHY or worse conditions, especially along Highway 138. Hazy conditions will be likely throughout the area due to local and regional fires.

Grants Pass			MODERATE to USG conditions throughout the day; brief UNHEALTHY possible		
Medford			GOOD to MODERATE AQI expected; periods of USG are possible		
Glide			Smoke impacts expected to continue with up to UNHEALTHY conditions possible		
Diamond Lake			Some clearing in the area from recent storms; but smoke returns		
Crater Lake			Recent storms brought relief; however, smoke impacts expected to continue		
La Pine			Continued smoke today. May see periods of USG in morning and evening.		
Crescent			Rain yesterday provided some relief; Variable conditions as smoke returns		
Summer Lake	No hourly data		Some relief from storms; smoke returning with UNHEALTHY conditions at times		
Klamath Falls			GOOD to USG conditions expected to continue; worst overnight

Air Quality Index (AQI)	Actions to Protect Yourself
Good	None
Moderate	Unusually sensitive individuals should consider limiting prolonged or heavy exertion.
USG	People within Sensitive Groups* should <b>reduce</b> prolonged or heavy outdoor exertion.
Unhealthy	People within Sensitive Groups* should <b>avoid all</b> physical outdoor activity.
Very Unhealthy	Everyone should avoid prolonged or heavy exertion.
Hazardous	Everyone should avoid any outdoor activity.
