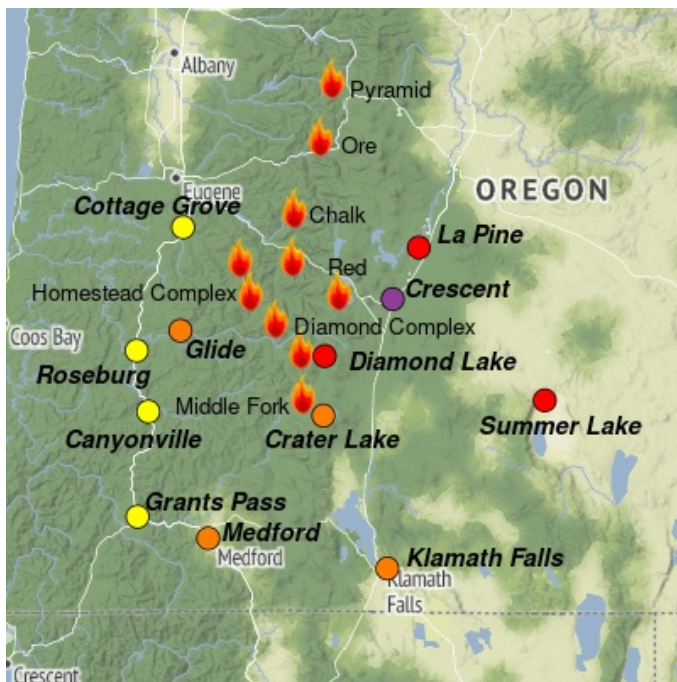

**Fire**  
 Numerous fires and fire complexes are ongoing within the Cascades. For the latest fire information, see <https://inciweb.wildfire.gov/>

**Smoke**  
 Hazy skies across the I-5 corridor this morning; with impacts expected west of the Cascades - areas to the south including Canyonville to Medford likely increased impacts. Areas within the National Forest(s) near fires will continue to see at least UNHEALTHY or worse conditions, especially along Highway 138. Smoke continues for communities east of the Cascades along the Highway 97 corridor with at least UNHEALTHY to VERY UNHEALTHY conditions. Hazy conditions will be likely throughout the area due to local and regional fires. Incoming cloud cover may slow smoke from clearing.

Roseburg			GOOD to MODERATE conditions expected this week; possible USG at times

Klamath Falls			Smoke impacts expected with periods of USG to UNHEALTHY possible

Air Quality Index (AQI)	Actions to Protect Yourself
Good	None
Moderate	Unusually sensitive individuals should consider limiting prolonged or heavy exertion.
USG	People within Sensitive Groups* should <b>reduce</b> prolonged or heavy outdoor exertion.
Unhealthy	People within Sensitive Groups* should <b>avoid all</b> physical outdoor activity.
Very Unhealthy	Everyone should avoid prolonged or heavy exertion.
Hazardous	Everyone should avoid any outdoor activity.
