

Fire

Fire activity showed some increase yesterday but no large jump in acreage. All fires will continue to produce smoke that will spread north and east. The Coffee Pot Fire is now 5,686 acres, the Chalk Fire 4,038 acres, and Moss Mountain 438 acres. Sunny skies and warmer temperatures are expected today, with the inversion lifting around 2 pm. Fire activity will be similar to yesterday with smoke being produced from interior pockets burning and firing of containment lines as conditions allow.

Smoke

Air quality was better than expected yesterday on the eastern side of the forecast area. Today, MODERATE conditions are expected near LaPine, Bend, Redmond, Madras and Sisters as smoke drifts northeast from fires both on the Willamette NF and those further south. Springfield, Sweet Home, and Detroit Lake should still see GOOD air quality with haze towards the eastern sky. Some smoke may settle in overnight. McKenzie and Oakridge will experience MODERATE air quality overall, however overnight conditions are likely to worsen as smoke settles in the valleys with expected winds and inversion. Smoke from fires to the south will continue to impact the forecast area.
