

Fire


There was 623 acres overall of fire growth on the Willamette Complex yesterday. The Coffee Pot Fire is now 5,866 acres, the Chalk Fire 4,777 acres, and Moss Mountain is at 578 acres. Pyramid, Slate, and Ore had minimal spread with interior pockets burning on Ore. Potential for plume development today on multiple fires with predicted weather.

Smoke

Smoke will impact most of forecast area today. MODERATE conditions are expected in Springfield/Eugene, Sweet Home, and Detroit. UNHEALTHY conditions are anticipated in the Oakridge area and adjacent river valley. The remainder of the forecast area to the north and east will see USG air quality as smoke drifts from fires on the Willamette and those to the south on neighboring forests. Low lying areas and river valleys may see persistent thick smoke throughout the day.

Air Quality Index (AQI)	Actions to Protect Yourself
