Evacuation Cente	sensors are being used in conjunction with ground crews to identify any areas that may be retaining heat. Information from drone flights is transferred electronically and reproduced on maps that show areas of concern so that firefighting operations may be adapted to address them. Continued progress has prompted release of some crews in an attempt to "right size" the operation and allow resources to be available for needs elsewhere. Approximately five hundred firefighters were made available at the end of shift last night. Suppression repair crews are coming in behind firefighters to install anti-erosion features such as water bars as well as identifying other landscape repair needs. A warming trend today is expected to continue through the weekend into Monday.
