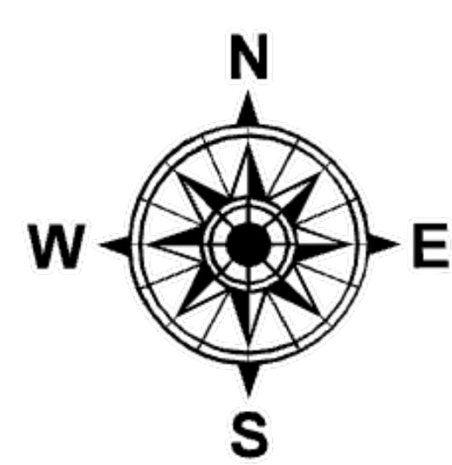

Wednesday, Sept. 4, 2024.  
Repair work on BLM lands is near complete in the Pony Bridge area. Work continues on the 600 Road. Repair work to dozer lines, hand lines and roads along the perimeter is nearing completion. Large fuels are being hauled from the Staples Creek area as brush and woody material is being chipped and spread on the burned area to prevent erosion.

Trucks are hauling salvaged timber from decks west of Marten Spring to a landing off Brice Creek Rd. at Blodgett Creek, 2232 NFSR. Road maintenance is continuing during night shift to allow trucking and repair work to continue during the day.

Large fuels are being hauled from decks created along the Hardscrable Road from Bohemia Saddle to north of Grizzly Mountain. These timbers are being hauled night and day to the Layng Creek Work Center. Drivers on Brice Creek Road and residents of Disston should use care and watch for heavy truck traffic.

Large fuels are being hauled from decks from Peg Leg Spur area to north of the county line. The removal of these hazardous trees is providing a safe workspace for firefighters and will make the area safe for the public on BLM managed lands. Firefighters continue to monitor interior islands of unburned vegetation. Warm, dry weather is forecast for the remainder of the week.

Firefighters continue to repair hand lines and dozer lines along Hardscrable Ridge. Interior islands of unburned vegetation are being monitored as warm and dry weather returns.

Chipping is near complete along Canton Creek Road. Crews continue to work to the east below Saddle Camp Butte repairing hand lines and roads used as containment lines.
