



West Fire Smoke Forecast

Smoke Synopsis

Yesterday, winds dispersed smoke to the northeast, mostly passing to the west of Winslow. Winslow saw some brief, light to moderate impacts in the evening. This morning, south-southwesterly winds above the Rim are helping to reduce smoke impacts to Payson and Pine.

Today, southwesterly (from the southwest) winds will disperse smoke to the northeast. Scattered, brief rain showers will also be possible throughout the day, as well as locally gusty and erratic winds. Such winds could push smoke in any direction. By evening and overnight, southwesterly winds are expected to continue above the Rim, reducing smoke impacts to areas below the Rim. When terrain-driven winds do develop, residual smoke will settle into local drainages. For tomorrow, southwesterly winds are expected again.



During the day today, smoke will move over/near Winslow, with light to moderate impacts possible later into the evening. Overnight, light to moderate smoke impacts are expected to East Verde Estates, Hwy 260, Pine, and Tonto Village, dispersing or lifting out by 10am. Light impacts are also expected to Payson, dispersing or lifting out by 10am.
